Minimum requirements: At least one major\*, one minor\* & 4 arts electives

Option	First 48 units	Second 48 units	
1	1 major*	1 minor*	4 arts electives
2	1 major*	1 minor*	1 minor*
3	1 major*	1 major*	

1 major = 48 units = 8 courses (8 x 6 units each course = 48 units)

1 minor = 24 units = 4 courses (4 x 6 units each course = 24 units)
