Study requirements for the Contemporary Music Production major:

This information should be read in conjunction with the program requirements for the Bachelor of Music.

This major requires the completion of 48 units, of which:

a maximum of 18 units may come from the completion of courses at 1000-level, and

a minimum of 18 units must come from the completion of courses at 3000-level.

The 48 units must consist of:
