

The Graduate Certificate of Studies is a flexible option for graduate studies at The Australian National University (ANU) for students whose needs are not met by following a program of study in a single academic discipline. Subject to meeting course entry requirements, you will be able to select courses from across the graduate course offerings available, allowing you to structure your studies and direct your learning in a way that meets your academic, personal and professional interests and enables you to develop skills and expertise in a range of learning areas, for example, a combination of courses in art history, environmental science, and management.

Career opportunities

The Graduate Certificate of Studies at ANU can be used as a pathway to a Master's degree, or to advance your career by allowing you to build jobready skills in your field, or in a completely different profession by developing new and must-have skills for today's competitive job market.

Students within this program will learn to:

- understand a body of theoretical and applied topics;
- apply skills in analysis, critical evaluation, and/ or professional functions to solve complex problems;
- demonstrate creativity and flexibility in the application of knowledge and skills to new situations; and
- communicate knowledge, ideas, and solutions to problems to both specialists and non-specialists.

Graduates from ANU have been rated as Australia's most employable graduates and among the most sought after by employers worldwide.

In 2021, the Global Employability University Ranking, published by the Times Higher Education, rated ANU as Australia's top university for getting a job for the 12th year in a row.



Pathways

The Graduate Certificate of Studies can be used as a pathway into any ANU Masters and Higher Degree Research programs, or to advance your career by allowing you to build job-ready skills in your field, or in a completely different profession by helping you to develop new and must-have skills in today's competitive job market.

Admission requirements

At a minimum, all applicants must meet programspecific academic/non-academic requirements, and English language requirements. Admission to most ANU programs is on a competitive basis. Therefore, meeting all admission requirements does not automatically guarantee entry.

Applicants must present;

- a Bachelor degree or international equivalent with a minimum GPA of 4.0/7.0, or
- have at least 10 years of work experience in an ANZSCO Skill Level 1 role.

In line with the University's admissions policy and strategic plan, an assessment for admission may include competitively ranking applicants on the basis of specific academic achievement, English language proficiency and diversity factors.
